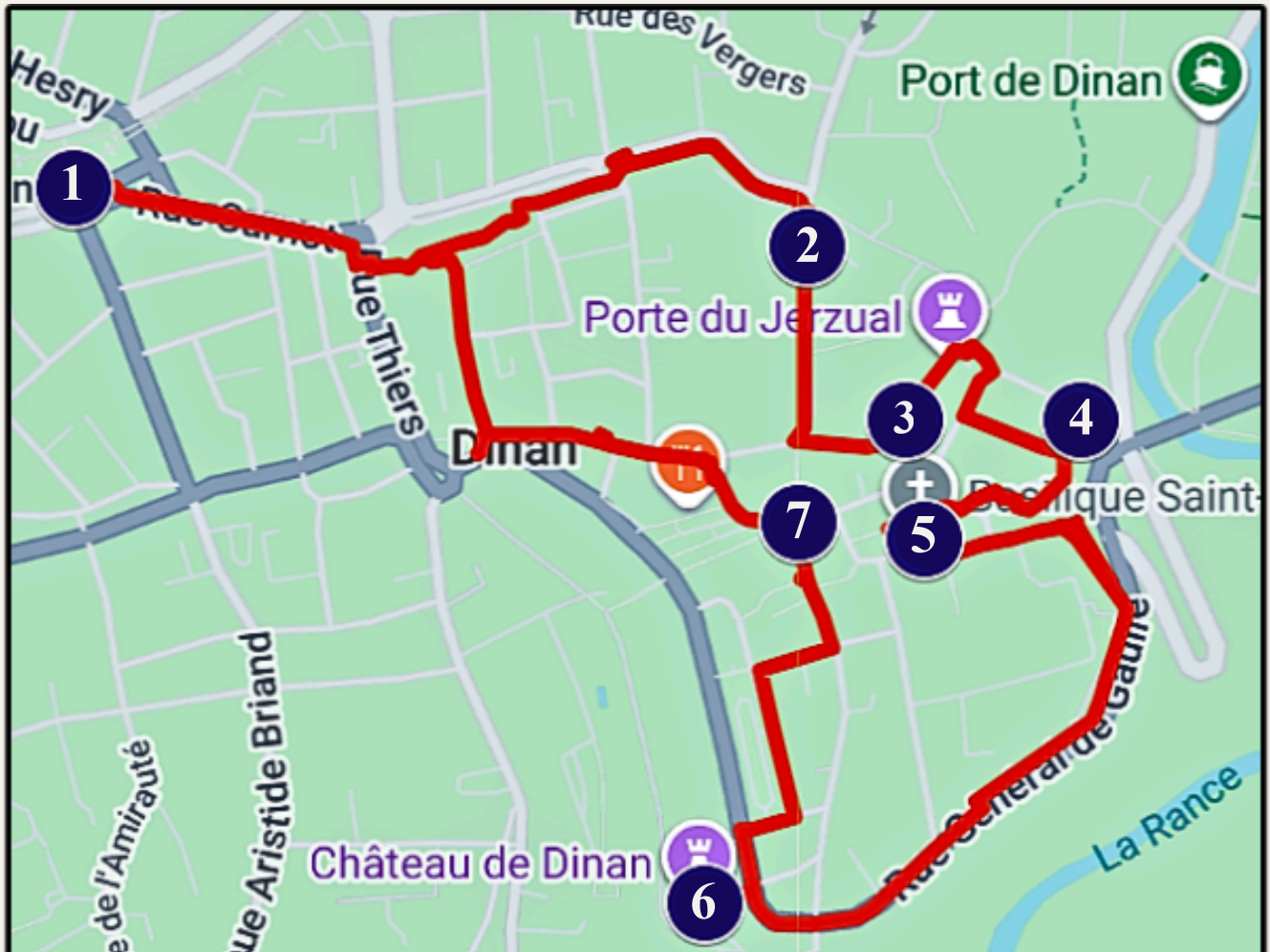


# Dinan Walking Map

## Salt & Sea Walking Guides

Distance: 4.5 km (2.8 miles)

Time: ~1 hour



1. **Dinan Train Station:** Arrive in Dinan by train.
2. **Saint-Malo Gate:** The stone entrance to the medieval town.
3. **Rue du Jerzual:** A steep cobbled road to the port.
4. **Dinan Ramparts:** Walk along the walls from the Jardin Anglais.
5. **Saint-Sauveur Basilica:** A romanesque & gothic church.
6. **Dinan Castle:** A glimpse into Dinan's powerful history.
7. **Historic Centre:** Explore half-timbered houses & cobbled streets.

# Follow this walking route to explore Dinan's ramparts, historic streets and viewpoints across the Rance valley.

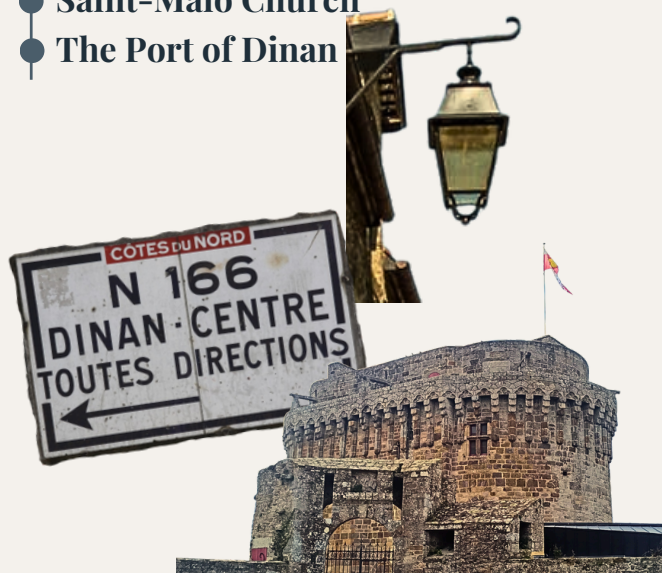

## Practical Tips

- **Getting There:** Dinan can be reached by train from Rennes via Dol-de-Bretagne or direct bus.
- **Climbing Rue du Jerzual:** You reach a gradient of 33% in places, wear comfortable shoes.
- **Best Time to Visit:** Spring/Autumn are relaxed. It is busy in the summer & during local festivals.
- **How Big is Dinan?** Most of the main sights are within a 15 minute walk of each other.
- **Market Days:** Thursday morning is market day and the Halles are open Tuesday to Saturday.
