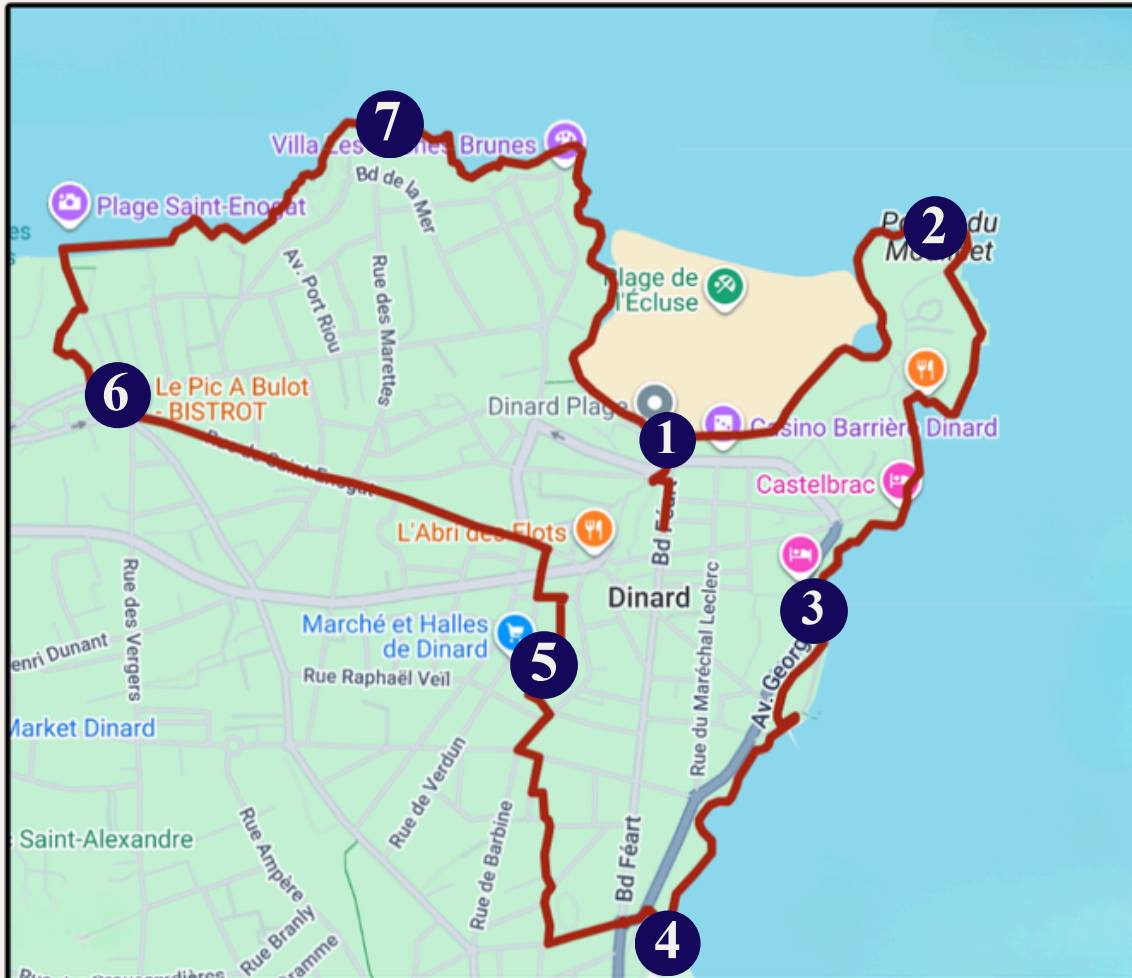


Dinard Walking Map

Salt & Sea Walking Guides

Distance: 7.4 km (4.5 miles)

Time: ~2 hours



- 1. L'Écluse Beach:** Start at the tourist office above Dinard's main beach.
- 2. Pointe du Moulinet:** Scenic headland with views toward Saint-Malo.
- 3. Claire de Lune Path:** A beautifully landscaped coastal walkway.
- 4. Prieuré Tidal Pool:** Climb the stone steps here back up into town.
- 5. Dinard Market Hall:** Browse for fresh produce and local goods.
- 6. Saint-Enogat:** Historic fishing village and quiet neighbourhood.
- 7. Chemin des Douaniers:** Dramatic coastal path back to town.

Practical Tips

- **Getting There:** Dinard can be reached by bus from Rennes or by ferry from Saint-Malo.
- **Tides:** Some coastal sections may be submerged at high tide - signed diversions are provided..
- **Best Time to Visit:** Summer brings a busy seaside atmosphere. Spring/autumn are quieter.
- **Market Days:** Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday mornings around the Halles de Dinard.
- **Beach Tents:** The striped tents on Plage de l'Écluse can be rented in summer.
